Drinking water is collected from springs, stored in a reservoir and then distributed. The first stage in the installation of the pipeline system took place at the end of the 19th century to supply water to the water fountains. In a second phase, people gradually joined the network to bring water into their buildings. Water hydrants (marked in red on the ground) are placed in front of the houses to supply them with drinking water. The third stage involved the removal of wastewater from the buildings. In 1948, a combined sewer system was installed to collect wastewater and rainwater. The irrigation network was installed underground in 1980 when Sarreyer was redeveloped.
